**TOWN WARRANT:** Board members reviewed and discussed proposed warrant articles. It was suggested that an italicized explanation be provided for Article 18 stating that Hampton Falls is looking to bring fees into line with surrounding communities. E. N. Small will also use the wording previously included on the 2007 warrant for Article 18 to better outline the Board's intent.

Once revisions are made, E. N. Small will make arrangements for printing the handouts and flyer that is mailed to residents.

The Board agreed to revisit the matters of setting money aside for a future purchase of an ambulance and revising the threshold amounts for elderly and disabled exemptions in 2009.

**MS6 (BUDGET) AND MS2 (DEFAULT BUDGET)** forms were signed by the Board for mailing to the Department of Revenue Administration and creation of the handouts provided at the deliberative session.

The Board tentatively set a date of Thursday, February 7, to meet to review the warrant and budget once more in anticipation of the deliberative session on February 9. The Board also tentatively scheduled January 30 or January 31 to meet to discuss S. C. Hanson's proposal of a handout for money warrant articles. E. N. Small will check with S. C. Hanson to see when he's available to meet.
