**MAP 9, LOT 9 – GRANT AGREEMENT:** E. N. Small provided the Board with a letter from counsel outlining complications that need to be addressed regarding the title opinion. He also provided the Board with documents necessary in order to complete the processing of the grant award.

**BLAISDELL – BROWN ROAD – DISTURBANCE TO WETLANDS:** Mr. Blaisdell has been clearing trees and brush on Map 5, Lot 12 on Brown Road. The Board has sent a letter outlining concerns as a result of the initial work done. Mr. Blaisdell has since been contacted by J. Dever who issued a citation and contacted the Wetlands Bureau. E. N. Small has spoken with the Fire Chief with respect to a permit to burn the brush as a complaint has been received that there is poison ivy in the brush piles. E. N. Small will follow up with the Department of Health on this matter.

**BRIMMER LANE – BLOCKED RIGHT OF WAY:** Information has been received that a property owner is partially blocking the right of way to the marsh. This matter has been forwarded to J. Dever.

**BUILDING INSPECTION POSITION – HIRING:** The deadline for applications has passed and it is now time to meet with the recruitment agency handling this matter to determine the process and interview questions as well as a standard to rate candidates. Suggestion is to establish an interview committee. It was suggested that the three members of the Board of Selectmen, Town Administrator, Fire Chief, Administrative Assistant and one additional person participate. Contact has been received from the Exeter Building Inspector volunteering to participate in the hiring process. E. N. Small will call to schedule a date and time to meet with the Local Government Center representative, Barry Cox.

**REGIONAL IMPACT NOTICE – TOWN OF SEABROOK:** Notice has been received informing of potential regional impact as a result of a site plan for a Target store and others.

**ROAD STUDY:** E. N. Small will prepare documentation for Board members to use in the annual rating of roadways. The Board will also identify property locations where property owners have constructed or installed fixtures or structures in the Town right of way as part of this review.
