TOWLE FARM ROAD: A price has been obtained from Pike Industries of \$17,601.80 to shim and pave Towle Farm Road. This road was rated a high priority on the road study, however, was held off due to truck traffic for the construction of homes on Marston and Swain. It has since been suggested to complete the shimming and paving of this road. R. B. Merrill reported that doing so will take care of all the roads in that area. He indicated that although this road is busy with traffic, that there should be little to no problem with traffic.

Once a public hearing is held to determine if this matter is to go to warrant, all projects before town boards go into abeyance. Legal counsel will need to review what's proposed.
