**OPEN BIDS – 5-YEAR SOLID WASTE CONTRACT:** E. N. Small reported that two bids have been received; one from Cape Disposal Company with a rate of \$2.55 per household and another from Waste Management with a rate of \$3.24 per household. The Board took this matter under advisement in order to allow review of the bids by the Solid Waste Committee and Town Administrator.

**ANNUAL EQUALIZATION STUDY:** The Board signed the annual equalization study form as prepared by the Assessor. The submission of data is an annual state requirement.

**TOWN MODERATOR:** E. N. Small reported that Chief Dirsa informed him of a complaint from the owner of the Village Market that the Town Moderator removed election signs in front of the Market. As a result of receiving this information, E. N. Small called the Secretary of State's office to verify the rules and was provided with a copy of RSA 664:17. The Secretary of State's office indicated that the Town Moderator has control of the area around polls but should not be removing political signs elsewhere in Town.
