SOLID WASTE- WHITE GOODS DAY:

E. Small explained that the following arrangements have been made for White Goods Day.

- Jeff Simpson will remove the brush, beginning on Wednesday. The lock to the main gate will be dummied that afternoon.
- Jim Nocella of Waste Management will be delivering 2 compactors and 6 roll offs on Thursday and Friday. The lock to the main gate will be dummied on those two days.
- East Coast Electronics Recycling will deliver its unit on Friday morning.
- Jarlath Fournier will collect fees and issue dump stickers. She will bring a price list and cash.
- Rick Merrill will be at the brush dump that day to assist. E. Small will ask him to bring 12 cones to the site, as he did in the spring.
- Northeast Resource Recovery Association will begin removal of the metals, Freon, tires and tanks the following week.
- S. Hanson offered to bring a table, chair, signs and coffee to the Brush dump early Saturday morning. Selectmen will also bring one of the smaller rectangular tables from the town hall. There will be two tables, one for food and the other for collecting fees and permits.

E. Small will send a copy of the site plan for all the containers that will be used on Nov 3 to all vendors and participants.

BUDGET WORKSHOPS

Selectmen changed the dates of the budget workshops from Nov 12 and 13 to Nov 19 and 20, 6 pm at the Town Hall.

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENTS- ROAD AND CULVERT IMPROVEMENTS

Pike Industries has offered to postpone the reclaiming and paving of Taylor River Road until the spring of 2008 and will honor its 2007 bid price.

Two prices have been received for reinforcing the retaining wall at the Brown Road culvert at Grapevine Run. E. Small recommended that the Town seek a third price from Dick Robinson. He will contact Dick Robinson this week.

WINTER MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

E. Small reported that Town Counsel Bart Mayer was very satisfied with the proposed agreement and did not see a need for additional provisions. The Board agreed to meet with Jim Ziolkowski on November 7 to sign the contract. S. Volpone suggested that E. small ask Jim to help with the editing of the State of NH's Snow and Ice Policy.

TAX WARRANT

Selectmen signed the property tax warrant for 2007 - \$ 7,671,625.
