

Hampton Falls Cemetery Trustees
December 11, 2007 – Final

Meeting was called to order at 7:03PM. In attendance were Cemetery Trustees Lillian Walker, Barbara Lizotte and Ed Price. Sexton Georgianna Swain was also in attendance. Minutes from the November meeting were reviewed. Motion to accept minutes as read by Lillian Walker, seconded by Ed Price. Unanimous.

Old Business:

- At Oak Lawn, Ed Price reported he had replaced the rope on one side of the gate with wire. The other side of the gate still needs to be done. He has also added more fill to some of the ruts.
- With regard to the Fabbri lot, L. Walker spoke with Mr. Fabbri on the phone and was told that he and his wife were responsible for placing the granite bench on their lot but that they were unaware the bench was encroaching on the adjacent lot, 20-j, or that they were required to present a plan for this action to the trustees prior to implementation. This will require further action in the spring.
- L. Walker met with Town Administrator Eric Small regarding the disbursement of funds from the Trust Fund for Town Cemeteries. Mrs. Walker attended the budget hearing and presented the budget, which has resulted in a \$900.00 reduction in the cemetery budget.

New Business:

- There was a burial for Mildred Moodie on December 3. Funeral director Mr. Gray called L. Walker who in turn put him in touch with Georgianna Swain who, as sexton, would be the person to handle the grave arrangements.
- Ed Price reported that as a result of the truck traffic to dig the grave, the ground, which was not yet frozen, was left with many ruts, which he hopes to fill in next spring with fill located at the back of the cemetery.
- There is no resolution of West View being turned over to the Town at this time. The Cemetery Trustees are still waiting to hear from Richard Winn.
- Lillian Walker and Ed Price offered their sincere thanks to Barbara Lizotte who had faithfully recorded, as secretary, the minutes of all the meetings and expressed sadness and regret at her departure.

B. Lizotte motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:00PM. Ed Price seconded. Next meeting February 12, 2008, 7:00PM at the Town Hall.
