Discussion resulted in additional **reduction**(s) made by the Board as follows:

As part of the discussion above, the Board agreed to a potential change the hours of the Brush Dump attendant to relate to times actually used by residents as opposed to the current schedule. The schedule may change to reduce the hours during the summer months when there is less activity and adjust other times based on activity. No change to the budgeted hours would result. Additionally, an estimate of offsetting revenue for use of playing fields was added to Line 4520.

The Board determined that it is not ready to seek advisory input through the warrant with regard to curbside collection of recyclables. Questions were raised with regard to annual mosquito control services as it relates to the proposed warrant article.
