A posted meeting of the Cemetery Trustees was held on Thursday December 1, 2022 at the Hampton Falls Town Hall.

Old business

Report of shrub and stump removal of two Alberta Spruce located at the LaGuardia lot at New Brookside Cemetery. Motion made by T. Beattie and seconded by W. Harrington to pay \$2500.00 to Going Green for this work. Passed

Attendance concerns regarding the sexton position were voiced. Chairman Bohm to make contact and follow-up in January.

Trustee Harrington spoke of the aesthetics of the white vinyl fence in front of Westview Cemetery. She has observed several old cemeteries with stone walls for enclosure and questioned whether this should be considered for Westview. Mention of the granite slabs located at the brush dump prompted T. Beattie to point out the large and irregular size of the granite. Cost of replacement is of concern. W. Harrington talked to Town Administrator regarding possible use of Frying Pan Lane Fund for this effort.

W. Harrington will represent the cemetery trustees regarding Wreaths Across America.

New business

Discussion continued regarding a private cemetery located at the corner of Nason and Kensington roads. Current owners are considering deeding this cemetery to the town. Discussion to continue in January.
