

## **Mission for the Hampton Falls Energy Committee**

The mission of the Energy Committee is to advise the Board of Selectmen, and other town employees and volunteers on energy savings measures that they can implement to: reduce energy use and cost, educate town residents, and track and adhere to energy relevant legislation

### **Saving Energy and Cost for Hampton Falls municipal buildings and facilities by:**

- Studying, planning, and utilizing energy resources for municipal buildings and built resources.
  - Identify energy and cost savings steps and make actionable recommendations to the Board of Selectmen.
  - Coordinate with other committee stakeholders and support execution of plans to save energy and costs
- Collecting, organizing, and evaluating municipal energy data (including fuels, electricity, vehicles and lighting) to baseline and monitor energy use in municipal buildings and facilities
  - Provide to the Board of Selectmen a report of energy use and cost with key recommendations, observations, and trends. *(this done in Town Annual Report)*

### **Educating town residents about reducing energy use and cost.**

- Provide relevant and timely resources to residents about energy efficiency and cost savings not only for municipal buildings and facilities but also for their homes.
  - Utilize the town's website, bi-monthly newsletter and outreach events
- Include interested town residents and other Hampton Falls committees and stakeholders in Energy Committee activities and findings.
- Coordinate with energy committees in neighboring towns to learn and share best practices in energy and cost savings.

### **Tracking energy relevant legislation**

- Follow Legislation and provide awareness on key issues relevant to the town and make recommendations.
