1) Roll Call: Beverly Mutrie, Mary Ann Hill, Phil Chura and Lou Gargiulo?

More pics and news articles from HS conveyed to Collin Garcia, author. Tricentennial committee just met and will be looking for groups to contribute activities. Discussed old-time things that were suggested...a la Fireman's Fair. They will be meeting more often now they have extra funds from the Frying Pan Lane fund.

We gave Phil permission to photograph as many more houses as possible this spring. Perhaps 20 more historic house photos left to do. It's most important to do the front and any sides visible from the road.

We discussed new building at Pelton Farm and believe its an eyesore. Would like to see the PB require a higher standard of architectural review of new development along Rte 1.

Phil has photographed Linnehan's (Going Green) on Rte. 1. Beverly will search for a picture of the building prior to removal of porch.

We discussed the DOT possible widening of Route 1 to relieve congestion and traffic backups. Beverly is on the Rte 1 Survey Committee. We realize that there are several historic buildings in the way. Perhaps best for those close to road and with historic merit to be placed on the State Register. Permission from owner needed. They are looking for public input.
