IMPORTANT – PLEASE TAKE NOTICE:

The Town of Hampton Falls will hold the spring household waste collection day this year.

“Safe distancing” requirements will be in place.

Please be patient as the number of people on the site at any one time will be limited.

Dump Permit Stickers are **not** required to participate.
Residents will be charged a \$10 per trip fee, with proof of residency.
Please note that fees apply to certain items accepted for disposal;
see fee listing on third page of this handout.

HOUSEHOLD WASTE COLLECTION DAY - Town of Hampton Falls, NH

Dump stickers are no longer required on Household Waste Collection Day (eff. March 2017), however, a \$10 per trip fee is charged (see page two for permitted items and other fees).

In accordance with the Hampton Falls **Solid Waste Ordinance**, only owners or lessors of real residential property in the Town of Hampton Falls, to include residents in Hampton Falls are permitted to use the various facilities available to the Town of Hampton Falls for the disposal of household solid waste originating within the confines of the Town.

At no time, either during curbside pickup or at the Town's Household Waste Collection Day (a/k/a White Goods Day) is commercially generated waste accepted for disposal.

A \$30 three-year **dump sticker** is required to dispose of brush and residents must bring items to the Brush Dump on the designated Saturday(s) allotted for disposal.

Yard waste (leaves, branches) may be disposed of on the owner's property by way of composted on site or burning with the approval of the Fire Warden. An attendant must be at the site at all times during the burning.

Yard wastes that originate outside the borders of Hampton Falls shall be prohibited from being disposed of on any property (public or private) within the Town of Hampton Falls. Yard wastes include but are not limited to leaves, brush, branches and tree limbs.

Any User may dispose of leaves, brush and slash five (5) inches or less in diameter at the Brush Dump located at the corner of Drinkwater and Parsonage Roads on Saturdays, April through November.

PROHIBITED OVERALL: *Stumps, commercial, industrial, construction and remodeling demolition and hazardous waste. An exception to this is a minimum amount of (less than ½ pickup truck load) household renovation debris that is acceptable for disposal at the Household Waste Collection Day.*

Examples of construction, remodeling, and demolition debris include, but are not limited to, ***carpeting, flooring, replaced windows and doors, sheetrock, paneling, metal clad wall partitions, concrete blocks, hazardous pressure treated wood materials, painted wood, wood with creosote.***

If an item or items is not acceptable by the Town's contract with the disposal contractor (items that cannot be burned), the Town cannot allow for disposal.

NOTE: Collection days are an opportunity to dispose of bulky items and other items not accepted curbside. The "Other Resources" listing available on the Town's web site offers other ways you can recycle and/or dispose of certain items.

(Stickers will be provided.) - The town appointed agent will inspect the used oil before accepting it for disposal.
