

Hampton Falls Curbside Waste Collection

The Board of Selectmen met with ELM Services, Inc. on August 24, 2020, to review statistics and operations under the new contract in conjunction with the Town's Solid Waste Ordinance.

Residents are reminded of the following:



Corrugated Cardboard: Clean, flattened and bundled corrugated cardboard, *tied in manageable sized bundles*, is allowed for disposal at the curb (or non-bundled can be placed in a designated container at the rear of the Public Safety Building, 3 Drinkwater Road).

Of concern is contamination, please take care to ensure there is no other product besides the clean corrugated cardboard in the tied bundle(s). Items such as greasy pizza boxes, other types of cardboard/paper, packing material and styrofoam are considered contaminants.

Trash (Municipal Solid Waste): Residents may place up to four (4) 30-gallon covered cans, or the equivalent in sealed bags of trash, curbside for collection each week. All cans must be covered and otherwise properly secured.

Recycling: Because of global changes to recycling, the industry has changed how they describe what can and can't be recycled in residential programs. They have moved away from the "look for the symbol," and "1-7" terminology, and instead are spelling out the TYPES of items that are included in the program. All recyclable material – office paper, plastics, tin cans, newspapers, cardboard – all go in the same recycling bin.
