- Only accept wrapped candy
- Stay with your family group
- Only one group at a time at homes
- Maintain social distancing of 6 feet
- Wear cloth masks alone or as part of your costume
- Carry hand sanitizer and use frequently

Some COVID Tips for Homes Participating in Trick-or-Treat

- Don't participate if you are feeling ill
- If participating, leave your outside lights on
- Consider placing candy directly on a table outside for trick-or-treaters
- Think of other creative, spooky ways to maintain 6-foot social distancing while giving out candy
- Sanitize any frequently touched surfaces several times during the event.
- Wear cloth masks
- Have hand sanitizer on hand and use frequently

Some General Safety Tips

- Be aware of traffic
- Alter costumes so they are not a trip hazard
- Wear reflective materials
- Carry a flashlight or glow sticks
- Inspect all candy at home before eating
