APPENDIX A - METHODS OF SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND FEES

COLLECTION SCHEDULE: Household trash and recycling will be collected on Fridays from residential properties within the confines of Hampton Falls.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE: Should a holiday fall on any day other than a Friday, collection will not be delayed. If a holiday should fall on a Friday, however, collection will be delayed one day and collected on Saturday.

BULKY WASTE: The Town of Hampton Falls holds two household solid waste collection day(s) each year. A fee, per disposal trip, will be charged in conjunction with proof of residency. Residents are to bring these items to the Hampton Falls Brush Dump, located at the corner of Parsonage and Drinkwater Roads, on the dates and times provided to the public in the spring and fall (See Appendix and Fee Schedule).

- Bulky waste items include, but are not limited to: sofas, chairs, televisions, rugs, mattresses. A fee will be charged for each *mattress or box spring that* is brought to the Hampton Falls Brush Dump.
- White Goods items include, but are not limited to: refrigerators, dishwashers, stoves, washing machines, clothes dryers, hot water heaters, air conditioners,. A fee will be charged for each appliance containing Freon which is brought to the Hampton Falls Brush Dump.
- During the fall collection, only bulky waste permitted in the compactor and allowable for disposal at the facility will be accepted.

RECYCLING: Recycling will be collected on Fridays from residential properties within the confines of Hampton Falls. All residents are encouraged to recycle in accordance with allowable items listed below in order to reduce the tonnage disposed at the landfill thus reducing the costs associated with disposal fees and budgeting funds in this regard. Single stream recycling includes the following listed items. There is no need to separate items for recycling, however, bins placed at the curb for weekly collection must be clearly marked "recycling."

COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLES SUBJECT TO CHANGE BASED ON INDUSTRY'S ACCEPTABLE MATERIAL

- plastics #1 through #7 bottles, jugs, tubs and lids
 glass bottles and jars
- newspapers, magazines, junk mail, office paper, paper bags
- corrugated cardboard (clean and bundled no larger than 2'x2'x2') OR MANAGEABLE BUNDLE

- frozen food paper packaging, paper egg cartons, milk and juice cartons and
 aluminum, tin and steel cans and *clean* foil.
- **Plastics:** soft drink, water and other beverage bottles, detergent and cleaning containers, milk and water jugs, shampoo, salad dressing bottles, pails.
- **Metals:** aluminum cans (soft drink, juise and other beverages), steel (tin, soup cans, metal jar lids), aluminum pie tins and clean foil.
- Paper: newspapers, magazines, old mail, flyers, folders, catalogues, paper bags, soft cover books.
- **Corrugated Cardboard:** flattened, and bundled (tied) can be left at the curb on collection day or brought flattened and loose to the container available for this purpose.

AUTOMOBILE TIRES: A fee will be charged for each unmounted automobile tire brought to the Hampton Falls Brush Dump. **Mounted** tires shall not be accepted at the Hampton Falls Brush Dump. Tires, up to and including 19" rim size (passenger), will only be accepted at this Brush Dump on Household Solid Waste Collection Day.

PROPANE TANK DISPOSAL: A fee will be charged for 5, 10- and 20-pound propane tanks as well as for 30, 40- and 100-pound propane tanks brought to the Hampton Falls Brush Dump and will only be accepted at this Brush Dump on Household Solid Waste Collection Day.

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING: A fee per electronics item recycled at Town sponsored household solid waste collection days will be charged for computers, computer monitors, printers/copiers/scanners/fax machines and televisions; a separate fee will be charged for each projection television. Keyboards/mouse, stereos, VCR/DVD players and the like are disposable at no charge. A fee, per disposal trip, will be charged in conjunction with proof of residency and residents must bring electronics items to the Brush Dump on the designated day in the spring only (See Fee Schedule, page 2).

MERCURY PRODUCTS: During Household Waste Collection Day(s), fluorescent lamps, thermostats, mercury switches and button cell batteries can be disposed in the shed at the Brush Dump provided for this purpose. Batteries, alkaline and lithium, (to prevent potential spark or ignition) can be disposed in the receptacle at the shed at the Brush Dump provided for this purpose.

YARD WASTE: Yard waste (leaves, branches) may be disposed of on the owner's property by way of composted on site or burning with the approval of the Fire Warden. An attendant must be at the site at all times during the burning.

In the event of a major storm, the Board of Selectmen will consider opening the Brush Dump for disposal of storm related branches, trees and limbs.

Yard wastes that originate outside the borders of Hampton Falls shall be <u>prohibited</u> from being disposed of on any property (public or private) within the Town of Hampton Falls. Yard wastes include but are not limited to leaves, brush, branches and tree limbs.

Any User may dispose of leaves, brush and slash five (5) inches or less in diameter at the Brush Dump located at the corner of Drinkwater and Parsonage Roads. A dump sticker is required for residents to participate (See Fee Schedule).

PROHIBITED OVERALL: Stumps, commercial, industrial,

construction and remodeling demolition and hazardous waste.

An exception to this is a minimum amount of (less than ½ pickup truck load) household renovation debris that is acceptable for disposal at the spring only Household Waste Collection Day.

Disposal of stumps, commercial, industrial, construction, remodeling or demolition waste and hazardous waste of any kind is prohibited from curbside disposal with a limited amount of household renovation debris permitted at the spring only household waste collection day (See Section II. B. and Appendix A) sponsored by the Town of Hampton Falls. Residents should contact waste removal services or seek other outlets for proper disposal.

Hampton Falls residents are encouraged to safely store household hazardous wastes and participate in properly authorized programs. Dates, times and collection sites may be posted at the Town Hall, the Town's web site and Post Office and are sometimes advertised in local newspapers. Once a collection site and date is set, the Town shall make every effort to notify residents of the Town.

Types of household hazardous waste include, but are not limited to: pesticides, rodent killers, pool chemicals, muriatic acid; antifreeze, brake fluid, engine degreaser, carburetor cleaner, creosote; drain cleaners, oven cleaners, furniture polish, metal polish, pharmaceuticals, photo chemicals; rust remover, wood preservatives, paint thinner, lead/oil based paint, solvents, degreasers, and any such other materials and substances defined by RSA 149-A:2 VII.
