Case #19-08-01: Application from Unitil Service Corp., for Final Public Hearing for Scenic Road Alteration Permit to perform storm resiliency work along a small portion of Mill Lane and along Stard Road. This would entail the removal/pruning of all vegetation growing under or over the lines and the removal of hazard trees threatening the lines. (Cross Reference Case #19-03-01)

Chris Moultroup, Forestry Supervisor for Unitil, told the group that he reviewed the trees originally being considered for removal on Stard Road last week and has reduced the list to 46 trees. Each of the trees were reviewed and explanations were given for why they have been included on the revised list.

After the Planning Board makes their final decisions, the trees that are to be removed, if any, will be marked with paint so that the tree contractor will have clear direction on what is to be done.
