Suggestions ranged from Heronfield Academy field, Silver Oak horse farm, Gov. Weare park, Tonry Tree Farm and Waked MOTION: To allow Glenn to investigate whether Heronfield might be available for a carnival and look for a date in September (Ohsberg/Montrone) Vote was UNANIMOUS

- Town History progress: discussion as to when the next payment to Colin is due and who will issue it. The Historical Society will cut him a check. MOTION: Glenn will deal directly with the Historical Society concerning issuing Colin his stipend (Montrone/French) Vote was UNANIMOUS

-2019 Warrant Article: MOTION: to allocate funds for a mailing in support of the 2019 Warrant Article (French/Montrone) Vote was UNANIMOUS
