## **UPDATES FROM February 7th, 2022 meeting**

- Susan presented an Operating Model for the Tricentennial Committee and Subcommittees to follow for open communication: when a Subcommittee or representative constituency has a meeting, the information is then submitted to the Tricentennial Board for status updates, review, or issue resolution, then the Tricentennial Board submits its recommendations to the Board of Selectmen. Hearing no objection, the Tricentennial Committee has begun to use this model.
- Susan presented an Issue Resolution process that specifies that a Tricentennial Committee member first notifies the Event Coordinator and Facilitator of a problem, then contacts the pertinent team member to verbally discuss and work toward a solution, or discuss it at a working session meeting, and report the results to the entire committee at the monthly Tricentennial Committee meeting. The proposal was then open for discussion and, hearing none, the Tricentennial Committee has begun to use this process.
- Susan then went over a model Program Approval process to be used to preapprove program recommendations by the Tricentennial Committee to present to the Selectmen in March. Hearing no objection, the Tricentennial Committee moved forward with this model.
- Ed updated the Committee on the manuscript at Peter Randall publishing, payments made and payments due.
